Why This Study Matters

Community rehabilitation providers (CRPs) are essential to helping people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) access employment and meaningful day services. Yet national data on CRPs—the services they provide, workforce capacity, and challenges—are limited and outdated.

By participating in this study, your organization will help fill a critical gap in national data on CRPs. The findings will inform policymakers and other decision makers about the realities providers face today.

About the Study

The Institute for Community Inclusion (ICI) at UMass Boston, and the American Network of Community Options and Resources (ANCOR) are conducting the **2026 National Survey of Community Rehabilitation Providers**.

The study is funded by the National Institute on Disability, Independent Living, and Rehabilitation Research (NIDILRR).

What You Will Be Asked About

The survey includes questions about:

- organizational characteristics
- services, trends, and strategic priorities
- budget and funding sources
- workforce characteristics
- technology use in employment services

Who Should Complete the Survey

We recommend that a senior staff member with broad knowledge of employment and day services—including service delivery, workforce capacity, budgets, and strategic priorities—complete the survey.
